Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, filed in the Registry on behalf of the respondent-State, is taken on record.

Through this petition, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.52 dated 27.02.2020, registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar, under Sections 353,186,224 and 225 IPC.

On 30.09.2020, a Coordinate Bench of this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned State Counsel seeks more time to file reply.

At his request, adjourned to 24.11.2020.

In the meantime, petitioners are directed to join investigation within one week from today. In the event their arrest is to be caused, they shall be admitted to interim bail till the next date of hearing, subject to their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating/Arresting Officer. The petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the

order dated 30.09.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harnek Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.09.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
