JAISHREE THAKUR, J.(ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0048 dated 01.05.2019 under Sections 354-B IPC and Section 7 and 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner herein would contend at the very outset that he withdraws the application of bail, however, prays that the petitioner will surrender before the Illaqa Magistrate within two weeks and that necessary direction be given to the Court below to consider his application for regular bail the same day.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant herein contends that an earlier FIR was also registered but the petitioner

compromised the entire matter by which an undertaking was given by him that the petitioner will not harass the complainant who was aged about 52 years.

I have heard learned counsel for both the parties and have gone through the record.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with an observation that in case the petitioner surrenders before the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of two weeks, his application for regular bail would be considered in accordance with law preferably within a period of three days.
