On 12.12.2019 following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that remaining payment could not be made as the petitioner has agreed to sell his house for ₹9,70,000/- and the sale deed is to be executed on 27.12.2019. He will bring demand draft of ₹2,50,000/- in the name of complainant on the next date of hearing. In the event of demand draft being not brought by the petitioner, this petition may be deemed as dismissed as withdrawn.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is not in a position to comply with the said order and the rigor of the order dated 12.12.2019 is attracted.
