Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.103 dated 18.08.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 336, 148, 149 and 25, 27(2) of the Arms Act, at Police Station Qadian, District Gurdaspur.

As per the allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of the complainant Daljinder Singh, Bhupinder Singh @ Bhinder armed with Kirpan along with the co-accused namely Gurwinder Singh @ Ginny (i.e. the present petitioner), Billa Sakala, Sukhraj Singh, Gursewak Singh and Sakattar Singh armed with swords and baseball bat and datar, attacked him in which, Bhupinder Singh @ Bhinder gave a Kirpan blow on the right side of the head of the victim whereas the petitioner has given a datar blow from its reverse side, on the right eyebrow of the victim.

On a Court query, it is found that none of the accused including the main accused i.e. Bhupinder Singh @ Bhinder and the

present petitioner, have surrendered before the trial Court and they are absconding from the process of law.

A perusal of the MLR show that as many as 05 injuries were suffered by the victim, which are on the head, face and the right elbow.

Considering the nature of injuries sustained by the victim, who was surrounded by the accused persons and was given merciless beatings, I find no ground to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
