Petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case, FIR No.51, dated 14.04.2019 under Sections 307, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1859, registered at Police Station Sirhali, District Tarn Taran Punjab.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion, it had been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that a compromise has since been effected amongst the parties and that it is a case of no injury.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Sewak Singh, has today informed that pursuant to investigation, the investigating agency has prepared a cancellation report, which is likely to be filed shortly.

In view of the aforesaid position, the petition is accepted and the interim directions dated 18.06.2019 issued by this Court are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
