Main case

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.49 dated 12.02.2020 registered under Sections 323, 325, 506, 427, 120-B, 34 IPC (307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Division No.2, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no injury is attributed to the petitioner and he has been in custody since 30.08.2020.

Learned State counsel assisted by the learned counsel for the complainant, states that the petitioner was involved in arranging a group of persons so as to commit the assault upon the complainant.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

No injury has been attributed to the petitioner and he has been in custody since 30.08.2020. The trial of the case will take time to conclude on account of prevailing COVID-19 pandemic. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
