This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondent-Corporation to quash the impugned order dated 28.5.2018 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate action on the legal notice 17.4.2018 (Annexure P-2) and reminder dated 24.3.2020 (Annexure P-4) as till date no action has been taken on the same.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondent-Corporation to look into the legal notice 17.4.2018 (Annexure P-2) and reminder dated 24.3.2020 (Annexure P-4) which has been sent to them and pass a speaking order with respect to payment of interest due from 31.3.2016 to 12.3.2018 as stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the
