The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 48, dated 30.01.2019, under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 354, 313 and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Adarsh Nagar, District Faridabad.

As per report received from the Mediation Centre, the parties have amicably settled their dispute. Learned counsel for the petitioner in compliance of the compromise settled between them before the Mediation Centre, has handed over two demand drafts in the sum of ₹7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh only) to the learned counsel for the complainant in Court today. Photocopies of the demand drafts have been retained.

Learned State counsel also does not controvert the said fact and submits that the petitioner is no longer required for investigation.

In view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the present petition is allowed. However, the petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.PC.
