Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents to grant 24% interest on delayed payment of gratuity due on 13.02.2013 which was released in the month of August, 2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 10.07.2020 to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/6, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Ms. Sunint Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5. At this juncture, Mr. Shashank Bhandari, Advocate has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.6. Complete copies of paper book have been supplied to them.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, to look into and decide representation dated 10.07.2020 (Annexure P/6) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
