Exemption is ordered as prayed for.

CRWP-7582-2020

The petitioners are both majors. They produced proof in respect of their dates of birth. The Aadhar Card of the first petitioner is placed on record in evidence of her date of birth being 1.1.2002. The second petitioner placed on record his Aadhar Card in proof of his date of birth being 1.1.2002. They claim to be married. However, the validity and legality of their marital status and relationship is not the subject matter of this writ petition. The petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from relations who are opposed to their relationship. The petitioners claim to have made a representation to the Superintendent of Police, Panipat (respondent No.2), in this regard.

As this Court does not propose to go into the merits of the matter, there is no necessity to put the unofficial respondents on notice or afford them an opportunity of hearing.

Trite to state, it is the bounden duty and obligation of the State to protect the lives and liberty of the people.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the Superintendent of Police, Panipat (respondent No. 2), to take appropriate action, as warranted and in accordance with law, upon the representation dated 30.8.2020 (Annexure P-5), and to extend adequate protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners, if necessary. It shall be open to the police authorities concerned to verify and confirm the identity of the petitioners and their claim.

It is made clear that this Court has not gone into the validity or legality of the marital status claimed by the petitioners and this order shall not be construed as this Court's approval of the said relationship or certification of its validity.
