This writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the final result dated 03.09.2020, announced by respondent No.2- Haryana Staff Selection Commission, with respect to a competitive examination held for direct recruitment of 4858 posts of Clerks (Group "C") in various Departments/Boards/Corporations in the State of Haryana. The writ petitioners claim that their names have been wrongly omitted from the list of the selected candidates.

Mr. Samarth Sagar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who has put in appearance pursuant to the service of an advance copy of the writ petition, has submitted that since the claim of the writ petitioners cannot

be decided without examining the record, therefore, respondent No.2 be kindly permitted to decide their representation dated 13.09.2020 (Annexure P12).

Mr. Verma has no objection to the proposal made by Mr. Sagar.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present writ petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2, through its Secretary, to decide the representation dated 13.09.2020 (Annexure P12) by passing a speaking order within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the writ petitioners through video conferencing.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of.
