1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for disobeying order dated 25.11.2019 in CWP No.31888 of 2019.
3. Learned DAG, Punjab states that orders dated 25.11.2019 in CWP No.31888 of 2019 have been complied with on passing of orders dated 31.08.2020 and that in view thereof, no further orders are called for in the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of, as such.
4. Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order dated 31.08.2020, in accordance with law.
5. ***Dismissed as withdrawn*** with the liberty, as prayed for.
