The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.226 dated 12.08.2020, under Sections 324, 323, 452, 506 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR that the petitioner and co-accused Yusuf Masih had grabbed the complainant and one of them had hit him with brick bat on his neck. He also contends that the injured has fully recovered from the injury. The petitioner is 26 years old and is not involved in any other case. He is in custody for about 01 months and 14 days.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jagdev Singh states that the challan is yet to be filed.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner, who is 26 years old, is in custody for 01 month

and 14 days, he is not involved in any other case, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
