The case has been taken up through Video Conferencing due to prevailing situation of COVID-19.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking protection from private respondent Nos.4 to 6 on the ground that the petitioners got married against the wishes of parents and brother of petitioner No.1. They are apprehending threat at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6. Copy of the marriage certificate is Annexure P-3.

The petitioners have already moved an application/representation (Annexure P-5) to Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, for providing protection to their life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as State counsel have submitted that necessary direction be given to the concerned police officer to look into the matter and decide the application/representation (Annexure P-5), moved by the petitioners.

In the light of the aforesaid, this criminal writ petition is hereby

disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, to look into the matter and decide application/representation (Annexure P-5), moved by the petitioners, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and if necessary, to provide proper security to the petitioners to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 6.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
