Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2 to decide and to initiate appropriate legal action on the representations dated 10.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) and 03.07.2020 (Annexure P-2) submitted by petitioner.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondents to consider and decide his representations dated 10.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) and 03.07.2020 (Annexure P-2), wherein authorities concerned have been requested to look into the alleged illegal acts of the Gram Panchayat.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. P.K.Longia, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 - Deputy Commissioner,

Yamuna Nagar to look into the representation dated 10.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) and if required, take necessary steps in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
