1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, is for taking action against the respondents for deliberately and intentionally disobeying order (Annexure P-1) dated 20.02.2020 in CWP No.4759 of 2020.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the learned State Counsel has furnished copy of order dated 25.11.2020 passed by the respondents, deciding the legal notice dated 02.10.2019 in compliance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 20.02.2020 in CWP No.4759 of 2020 and in view thereof, he does not wish to pursue the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 25.11.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. The same is not opposed by learned State Counsel.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn*** with the liberty, as prayed for.
