The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference

alternative remedy in Clause 8 (xiv) of the State Transport Haryana
Employees Transfer Policy 2018, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks
permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail the
remedies.

Learned counsel for the State appearing on advance notice
submits that if such a representation is made, the same would be decided
expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

In case the petitioner make representation within one week after complying with the conditions laid down under Clause 8 (xiv) of the aforesaid transfer policy, same be decided within six weeks, but no later than 30th November, 2020.
