Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and their associates.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR No.200 dated 29.07.2020, under Sections 363 and 366 IPC, Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar, has been got registered by respondent No.5 against Raja son of petitioner No.2 and brother of petitioner No.1, with the averments that he had enticed his daughter under the pretext of marriage.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that the whereabouts of Raja are not known to the petitioners, but the official respondents No.3 and 4 are harassing the petitioners and asking them to come to the police station even in odd hours. The petitioners have also

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made a representation (Annexure P-2), sent through consignment No.Z47869832 dated 08.09.2020, to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, which has not been decided till date.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, if their representation (Annexure P-2), sent through consignment No.Z47869832 dated 08.09.2020, is decided by respondent No.2 within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only, at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Amit Mehta, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners during the hearing of the present petition, but without going into the merits of the case, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-2), sent by the petitioners through consignment No.Z47869832 dated 08.09.2020, and decide the same within one month after receiving the copy of this order, in accordance with law.
