[1] Result of the petitioner for the post of Mandi Supervisor-cum-Fee Collector under the SBC Category has been produced in a sealed cover. On opening the same reveals the petitioner to have obtained 136 marks out of 225 marks, as against 154 marks obtained by the last candidate selected in the General Category.

[2] Learned AAG, Haryana, states that all posts of SBC Category were converted into General Category. Consequently, the candidature of the petitioner also has to be considered under the General Category. The result, as well as the cut off marks produced by learned AAG, Haryana, has been shown to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the writ petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn.***

[4] Result of the petitioner be re-sealed and returned to learned AAG, Haryana.
