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**ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)**

This is 3<sup>rd</sup> petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No.76 dated 09.03.2015 under Sections 302, 323, 34, 307 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran; first one was dismissed as withdrawn on 20.03.2017 and second was dismissed on merits on 27.02.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on an earlier occasion, the petitioner was granted interim bail for some time, as he is an old patient of CKD.

Medical status report of the petitioner filed in the Court today, is taken on record. In this report, it is recorded as under: -

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*“Swaran Singh s/o Ajit Singh is undergoing treatment for CKD since 19.12.2019 with chief c/o Breathelessness, nausea/vomiting, slurring of speech, altered sensorium, difficulty in walking, generalized weakness, swelling lower limbs.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is in custody for the last five years and since the entire evidence is concluded, the trial Court be directed to expedite the trial.

Learned State counsel submits that now the case is fixed for defence evidence and a perusal of the orders shows that despite that the trial Court has taken up the case and passed the various orders, in which it is repeatedly stated that no defence evidence is present and on some dates, the petitioner was not there, as he was given medical treatment by the Medical Officer of Central Jail, Amritsar.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of and it is directed that on conclusion of the defence evidence, the trial Court will dispose of the main case within a period of two months.

It will be open for the trial Court to hear the arguments either by virtual or actual Court as well as to seek the written synopsis from the parties.
