In the present petition filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the hands of private respondents Nos.4 and 5, who are parents of petitioner No.1. The same is sought on account of their marriage which has taken place on 17.09.2020 as per Hindu rites and rituals at Shri Bhramari Devi Jan Kalyan Sanstha (Regd. No.616), 222 Mansa Devi Market, Sector-4, Panchkula. The photographs of marriage and marriage certificate have been appended as Annexures P-3 and P-4.

The date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 16.12.2001 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) and the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 19.08.1995 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-2).

A representation dated 17.09.2020 (Annexure P-5) has also

been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and in view of the binding precedent of the **Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478**, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
