Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.146 dated 17.08.2020, under Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act and Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Central Sector-17, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 03 cartridges were recovered from the dashboard of the car of the petitioner . He also contends that the petitioner had a property dispute with a police officer from Punjab and he was pressurizing him to compromise the matter. He has referred to the copy of the compromise Annexure P-7. He further contends that the petitioner was not involved in any other case prior to the registration of the present FIR and after registration of the instant case, he was involved in another case along with his family members due to the property dispute. He is in custody for over a month.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Gurjiwan Singh states that challan has not been filed.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over a month, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
