Records of the case show that vide order dated 23.09.2020
passed by this Court, notice of motion was issued for 09.12.2020.

Today on the resumed hearing of the case, learned State
counsel on instructions from respondent No.3-Civil Surgeon, Ferozepur,
submit that during the pendency of the present writ petition the Board of
Directors (consisting doctors-Dr. Sanjeev Kumar Gupta, Dr. Rahinder
Kumar Manchanda, Dr. Jasdev Singh Dhillon) have sent report regarding
complaint by the petitioner to the Civil Surgeon. In this report *inter alia* it
has been concluded that the allegations levelled in the complaint are
baseless and devoid of substance.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for petitioner submits that SIT be constituted with higher officials unconcerned with medical profession to enquire into the matter.

This Court in view of the above circumstances would dispose of the present petition by observing that the report dated 30.09.2020, by the Board of Directors has been circulated on the *Whatsapp* group, the petitioner if so advised may challenge the same in separate proceedings. However, no further orders are called for in the present petition.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to avail such other remedy that are available to her.
