Challenge in this writ petition is to the order dated 24.05.2019 (Annexure P-10), whereby the Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Patiala Division, Patiala, set aside the selection of the petitioner as a Salesman in the fifth respondent Society on the ground that the constitution of the Selection Committee was in violation of the Rules and directed the Managing Committee of the Society to constitute a Selection Committee afresh as per law for carrying out the selection once again.

It is not in dispute that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the fifth respondent Society constituted a new Selection Committee and

selections were held by the said Committee on 19.07.2019. It is also an admitted fact that the petitioner participated in the said selections but emerged unsuccessful. Pursuant to the aforestated selection, the fifth respondent Society is stated to have made a fresh appointment on 22.07.2019.

In the light of the later development, with the tacit consent of the petitioner who participated in the second selection process, the grievance raised by her in this writ petition no longer survives for consideration on merits.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
