Petitioner has filed the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking protection of her life and liberty from respondent Nos.5 and 6, who are her parents. It is alleged that she has married with Amarnath Harsh, who is stated to be already married. Thus she is in a live-in relationship with one Gurpreet Singh.

The petition is bereft of details as to when she got married and when she left her husband and when she met Gurpreet Singh. Neither there has been mention that the petitioner from the marriage has any children and in whose custody they are and whether she has resorted to her legal remedy against her husband. In such circumstances, no order of protection can be passed.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner prays for liberty to withdraw the present petition and to file a fresh one with better particulars.
