The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Notice of motion to official respondents.

Mr. Baljinder Virk, DAG, Haryana puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Let copy of the paper book supplied be supplied to him.

After hearing the two sides, the instant petition stands allowed in view of right envisaged by virtue of Article 21 of the Constitution of India, which is applicable even to all living beings irrespective of their nationality with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-5) within the framework of law. Meanwhile, the official respondents shall ensure due protection to life and personal liberty of the petitioners and shall take prompt and immediate action in accordance with law in case any instance of threat is brought to their notice by the petitioners. However, this order will not comment upon the legality and validity of the marriage so claimed to be solemnized between the petitioners.
