(The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for the release of alleged detenues mentioned in para No.2 of the petition from illegal detention of private respondents No.4 and 5.

Vide order dated 21.09.2020, respondent No.2-District Magistrate, Ludhiana was directed to treat this petition as a complaint under the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976, take immediate action in accordance with law within a period of one week and to file status report. However, no status report in compliance with the above said order has been filed today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that on intervention of respondent No.2-District Magistrate, Ludhiana, all the

detenues have been released, paid wages due to them and have been allowed to go to their native place and the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
