This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 105 dated 22.05.2019 under Sections 406, 420 and 506, IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harpal Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 13.06.2019, petitioners have already joined investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that as per Settlement Agreement dated 15.10.2019 arrived at between the parties, he has received Demand Draft No. 133191 dated 28.01.2020 amounting to Rs. 11,00,000/- favouring Bhajan Kaur @ Harbhajan Kaur (complainant) from learned counsel for the petitioners. He further submits that the remaining terms and conditions of Settlement Agreement, as detailed above, especially that an amount of Rs. 5,70,000/- to be kept for the upbringing of daughter-Amandeep Kaur, have already been complied with at the instance of the petitioners.

It is pertinent to mention here that the Branch Manager, Gramin Bank, Umarpura, Batala shall allow the petitioners to operate their accounts henceforth, with the rider that the petitioners have to comply with the condition No. 8 (c) of Settlement Agreement dated 15.10.2019 that the amount of Rs. 5,70,000/- is to be kept for upbringing of daughter-Amandeep Kaur.

In view of above, petitioners have already joined investigation and they are no more required for further investigation and especially the fact that they have complied with the terms and conditions of the Settlement Agreement dated 15.10.2019. Learned counsel for complainant has given concurrence to above said fact.

Keeping in view the above, order dated 13.06.2019 granting interim bail to petitioners, is made absolute. Petitioners shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
