The present contempt petition has been filed for non compliance of order dated 30.07.2020, vide which, a direction was issued to Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot to take decision on the representation of the petitioner expeditiously and take necessary action, if so warranted.

Reply has been filed stating therein that the order has been complied with. It is stated that the matter was enquired and as per relevant part of para No.5 of the said reply:-

“.....It has come to notice that Pardeep Singh son of the applicant Balkar Singh has solemnized love marriage with Anita with his own consent. But there is some domestic issue amongst them. In this regard, Anita has filed the court case against her husband Pardeep Singh and her father in law Balkar Singh. Because of the above reason, the applicant Balkar Singh don't want to keep his son Pardeep Singh and want to evict his daughter in law Anita from his house.

As the matter is civil in nature and already subjudice in the Ld. Court. The complaint was recommended to be filed. Sh. Gursimran Singh, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Pathankot accepted the report requiring no further action.....”

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed accordingly.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
