Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking grant of concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.192 dated 28.05.2019 registered under Sections 323, 341, 379, 506, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has *inter alia argued* that in the present case it is a family dispute and he has been wrongly roped in the present FIR. He has submitted that even interim compensation of Rs.25,000/- and costs of Rs.5,000/- have already been paid by way of bank draft to the learned counsel for the complainant. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that vide Order dated 14.06.2019, he was directed to join the investigation and interim bail was granted to him. In pursuance of the aforesaid orders, petitioner has already joined the

investigation and fully co-operating with the investigation process.

Per contra, learned State counsel on instructions from HC Satbir Singh has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully co-operated with the investigation process. Therefore, his custodial investigation at this stage is no more required in the case.

Learned counsel for the complainant also endorses the stand taken by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed. Order dated 14.06.2019 is made absolute.
