The present petition is filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.46 dated 18.4.2020 registered under Sections 376, 506 of IPC 1860, Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur.

A perusal of the FIR shows that the prosecutrix was willingly staying with the petitioner. However, the girl appears to be upset as no marriage has taken place. The petitioner is in custody since 19.4.2020. Whether the petitioner had promised to marry her or not, is a matter of trial.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
