The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.14 dated 17.05.2019, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Mohali.

During the course of proceedings before this court, the matter had been referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court where a Settlement/Agreement dated 26.07.2019 has been effected between the parties, which is available on record. Even an affidavit of petitioner-Tarun kanodia is available on record, in which the petitioner submits that he would be abide by the terms of the compromise arrived at between the

parties.

Counsel for respondent No.2 endorses the statement made by
counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Shyam Singh,
submits that at the present moment, both the parties are residing together.

In view of the facts that the matter stands settled between the
parties, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is
allowed subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2
Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
