This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned action of the respondent wherein the petitioner was not selected to the post of Clerk in pursuance to the advertisement No. 05/2019 even though he had secured 63 marks which was much higher than the cut off marks in the category of Person with Disability (Autism & multiple disabilities) and the marks secured by the last selected candidate, who had secured 47 marks. It has been further contended that even though, he has been repeatedly making representations to the respondent-Commission for correction of the final result and for including his name in the list of successful candidates, however, the respondent has not taken any action so far.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent-Commission to look into the letter and online complaint both dated 7.9.2020 (Annexure P-7) and take appropriate action.
