On 23.9.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 0127, dated 24.08.2020, registered under Section 323, 324, 354, 148 & 149 IPC (offence under Section 452 IPC added lateron), at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.

As per the case of the prosecution, there was a scuffle between the members of two families who are closely related to each other. The dispute appears to be arising from ownership of a school. It has been noticed that a cross version has also been registered by the petitioners against the first informant and the others. It is also not disputed that the injuries caused are simple.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused of the petitioner, have already been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail vide order dated 17.9.2020, passed in CRM-M-28286-2020.

Notice of motion.

On the request of the Court, Ms. Samina Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and prays for time to seek instructions.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to let the petitioner join investigation.

In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim pre-arrest bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List alongwith CRM-M-28286-2020 on 07.10.2020.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 23.9.2020 is hereby made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
