The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.232 dated 29.5.2019 registered under Sections 323/ 452/ 506/ 120-B/ 34 at Police Station Sector 14, Gurgaon.

Both the parties are *ad idem* that the parties have resolved their differences by way of amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 has no objection in case the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioners is made absolute.

Perusal of the order dated 17.6.2019 would show that the arrest of the petitioners was stayed till the next date of hearing. Thereafter, the interim protection was ordered to be

continued till date.

In view of consensus arrived at between the parties, the petitioners shall appear before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their appearance before the Investigating Officer, they shall be granted bail on their furnishing adequate bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

(i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;

(ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

(iii) that the petitioners shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
