The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Ashish and nine others, have filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the final result dated 03.09.2020 (Annexure P-8) qua the petitioners announced by respondent No.2, in respect of the advertisement No.05/2019 for the direct recruitment for 4858 posts of Clerks (Group C) for various departments/boards and corporations that has been declared/announced by respondent No.2 without prior scrutiny and perusing the OMR sheet (Answer Sheet) and answer key of the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, based on the pleadings, submits

that the petitioners had applied for recruitment to the post of Clerk (Group C) in pursuance to advertisement dated 20.06.2019 (Annexure P-1). It is submitted that result has been declared on 03.09.2020, but, the grievance is that the roll numbers of the petitioners have not been included amongst the successful candidates, despite they are securing more than cut off marks, as per their own assessment. Counsel further submits that for the same/similar grievance, the petitioners had submitted a representation dated 13.09.2020 (Annexure P-9) to the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula (Haryana).

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioners submit any representation before the Competent Authority, the same shall be got examined by the Competent Authority within three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the Competent Authority by the Registry through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.

Civil Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
