The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in complaint submitted by Balwinder Singh and Sukhwinder Singh, before the SHO/In-charge, Police Station NRI, District Moga.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. H.S.Multani, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and upon instructions from SI Tejinder Singh, he informs the Court that a complaint submitted by Kamaljit Singh is pending investigation and no FIR has been registered as yet. He prays for dismissal of the petition as being premature.

I have considered the submissions of the parties.

It is not in dispute that an inquiry is pending on the complaint submitted by Kamaljit Singh, who is the attorney of Sukhwinder Singh, against the petitioner, though no FIR has been registered till now.

Therefore, keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, it is directed that in case an FIR is registered against the petitioner on the basis of the allegations levelled by Sukhwinder Singh, the petitioner will be served with an advance notice of three days before any coercive action is taken against him.
