This is a first petition for grant of regular bail filed by petitioner-Baljeet Singh. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition, however, a direction be issued to the trial court to conclude the trial expeditiously by giving short adjournments.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn. The trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously by fixing short dates refusing to grant adjournment except for justifiable reasons which be mentioned in the interim order itself.

Of course, petitioner-accused would not seek any unnecessary adjournment for the purpose of cross-examination of PWs or cause delay in

leading defence evidence. The whole exercise be preferably

completed within a period of six months from the date of receipt of copy of
this order in the trial Court.
