Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.102 dated 28.6.2020, under Sections 307, 323, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bond Kalan, District Charkhi Dadri.

In the present case, on the last date of hearing i.e. 24.09.2020 when the notice of motion was issued, learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted that the main accused in the present case was Rahul, who has already been arrested. So far as the present petitioners are concerned, petitioner No.1 is mother and petitioner No.2 is her son, who is brother of Rahul.

The controversy in the present case was also a case of cross

version where both the parties had a scuffle with each other. Learned counsel for the petitioners has further submitted that even the petitioners have also suffered injuries at the hands of complainant and his brother and that the complainant and his brother was the aggressor party but no FIR has been registered against them despite giving of the complaint vide Annexure P-1. The petitioners were directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and interim protection was granted to the petitioners.

Today Mr. Naveen Sheoran, DAG, Haryana has stated on instructions from ASI Ram Niwas that in pursuance of the order dated 24.9.2020 both the petitioners have already joined the investigation and they have also co-operated with the investigation process. He has further submitted that as per instructions the custody of the petitioners is no longer required.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 24.9.2020 is hereby made absolute.
