In the light of the pleadings, there are disputed questions of facts which cannot be gone into in the present writ petition and, therefore, the counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the writ petition to approach the Civil Court for redressal of the grievance, as has been highlighted in the present writ petition.

In view of the prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Civil Court.

The time spent by the petitioner in pursuing the present writ petition shall not come in the way of the petitioner to be counted towards the delay.

In case the petitioner files a civil suit within a period of three weeks from today, the suit shall be treated to be one within limitation and proceeded with in accordance with law.
