By this petition, the petitioner has challenged the action of the respondent No.3 in not allotting the work despite the petitioner having been declared as a successful tenderer.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, Assistant Advocate General has accepted notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. She has very fairly stated that the petitioner has a remedy of an appeal before respondent No.1 and therefore, he should be relegated to that remedy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner filed an appeal before the respondent No.1 within one week from today, the respondent No.1 shall decide the same within four weeks thereafter in accordance with law by passing a speaking order.
