On 28.09.2020, the following order had been passed:-

“All the cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition filed under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.25, dated 10.06.2019, having been registered at Police Station Mukandpur, District SBS Nagar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 120B of the IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional Regulation Act, 2014.

After arguing for some time, when this court was not agreeing with the contentions raised by the learned counsel, he submits that he may be permitted to seek instructions as to whether the matter can be compromised between the parties by return of the money as is alleged to have been taken by the petitioner and his co-accused (in terms of what has been stated in the FIR).

In view of the above, on his request, adjourned to 06.10.2020.”
