This revision was filed by the petitioners to challenge the order dated 07.10.2017, whereby they were summoned as an additional accused in case FIR No.31 dated 20.04.2017, under Sections 302 and 120-B IPC, Police Station, Sekhwan, District Gurdaspur.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned senior counsel that after summoning of the petitioners, they participated in the trial proceedings and cross-examined the prosecution witnesses. He fairly states that the prosecution has examined all the witnesses and the case is now fixed for defence evidence.

Considering the above, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court does not find any reason to exercise the revisional jurisdiction.
