The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Anticipatory Bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.131, dated 12.07.2019, under Sections 307, 506, 328, 148, 149, 323 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Bass, District Hisar, Haryana.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Anmol Malik, DAG, Haryana, to accept notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the Paperbook be supplied to him.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of the court to the order passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-13796-2020, titled as **“Rajbir Singh Vs. State of Haryana”** on

19.06.2020, vide which co-accused Rajbir Singh, who stands on a similar footing with the petitioner, was directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court, in view of the fact that he had been declared a Proclaimed Offender/Person, and it was observed by the Co-ordinate Bench that otherwise on merits, it was a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail.

5. The present petitioner stands on a same footing to that of her co-accused Rajbir Singh.

6. As such, the petitioner, who is a 65 years old lady, is now directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within a period of one week from today, after which an appropriate order on her application for bail, if so filed, shall be passed by the Ld. Trial Court expeditiously.
