All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to respondents no.1 to 4 to protect his life and liberty at the hands of respondents no.5 to 7, and to take legal action against respondent no.5, for extending a threat to him (as alleged).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to a property dispute with respondents no.6 and 7, who reside in England, respondent no.5, who is their attorney (carrying an instrument of general power of attorney as contended), is threatening the petitioner, who is 69 years old, and in fact he had even entered his house with some 'goons' and threatened him.

In respect of his grievance, the petitioner is stated to have made a representation to the DGP, Punjab, and the Commissioner of Police,

Jalandhar.

Without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, i.e. respondent no.3, to go into the allegation made by the petitioner and to ensure that his life and liberty are duly protected within the parameters of law.

An order be passed by the Commissioner of Police on the representation stated to have been made by the petitioner, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If the representation is not traceable, this petition shall be treated as a representation.
