In the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents Nos.4 to 7, who are relatives of petitioner No.1, on account of their marriage which has taken place on 18.09.2020 as per Hindu rites and rituals at Shiv Durga Mandir, village Ferozepur, Sector-19, Panchkula. The marriage certificate and photographs of marriage have been appended as Annexure P-3 and P-4.

The year of birth of petitioner No.1 is 2000 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) and the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 08.10.1991 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-2). It is averred that petitioner No.2 is working as a electrician and earning Rs.22,000/- per month and petitioner No.1 is doing the work of stitching and embroidery and they are able to run

their livelihood.

A representation dated 18.09.2020 (Annexure P-5) has also been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and in view of the binding precedent of the **Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478**, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.

In case, there is any material concealment about any of the facts mentioned in the petition, it will be open to any of the parties to bring the same to the notice of this Court then this order will be liable to be withdrawn.
