During the course of hearing of the regular bail application bearing No. CRM-M-29893-2020 of accused/petitioner-Vicky Saini in a case bearing FIR No.98 dated 01.09.2018 under Sections 363, 376 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 6 of the POCSO Act and Section 3 of the SC/ST Act registered at Police Station Women, Panipat, District Panipat, the counsel has pressed for grant of interim bail to the petitioner to enable him to solemnize

his marriage with the prosecutrix which is stated to be on 30.09.2020.

Upon notice, report of the State was called for. The status report along with supporting documents have been received from the State through email and as per the statement of the respectables of the area, statement of Ruby-elder sister of the prosecutrix, Shyam-husband of Ruby, Mamtesh-aunt of Vicky, Veena Devi-neighbour of the prosecutrix, along with supporting documents comprising of marriage invitation card and report of the police, proves that the petitioner is getting married with the prosecutrix on 30.09.2020, according to Hindu rites and ceremonies.

The claim of the petitioner is duly supported by the statements of the relatives, respectable of the area as well as documents and report of the police. Since, the girl by now, as per the contentions, has attained the age of majority and the couple is getting married, this Court feels that detention of the petitioner should not come in the way of this sacrosanct relation that is going to be created.

In light of the submissions of the two sides and on perusal of the records, this Court deems it expedient to allow interim bail to the petitioner for a period of one month from the date of his release from jail subject to his furnishing of heavy bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1 lac with two local sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned Authority/District Magistrate. The

petitioner will surrender before the jail authorities on 01.11.2020 at 10.00 AM

The present petition in light of order dated 25.09.2020 stands disposed off accordingly. However, this will not come in the way of the petitioner seeking subsequently regular bail in this case.
