It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been suffering at the hands of her in-laws. She had been subjected to cruelty, beatings and inhuman behaviour done with her by respondent Nos.4 to 7 from the very inception of marriage because of their greed and ingenuine demands. It is also asserted that the petitioner has been

tortured to the extent that iron objects were inserted into her private part by respondent No.4, Gurwinder Singh son of Kulwant Singh in connivance with respondent Nos.5 to 7. Petitioner was even subjected to severe beatings by respondent Nos.4 to 7 on 24.08.2020 and on the same date she informed her mother telephonically about the incident, who took her back at around 08.30 P.M. She got herself medically examined on 25.08.2020 and the prescription slip in this regard is annexed as Annexure P-2, according to which there was vaginitis injury, swelling and bleeding. Subsequently also, she is being taking medical aid and one of the medical receipt/prescription slip dated 11.09.2020 is annexed as Annexure P-3, which again reflects the same position. The petitioner has submitted a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran on 29.08.2020 (Annexure P-1), highlighting all these aspects but no action is said to have been taken on the same.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 29.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) and take action against the private respondents in accordance with law.

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon and keeping in view the representation dated 29.08.2020 (Annexure P-1), which is supported by the medical record/prescriptions, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 29.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) and take a decision thereon within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified

copy of this order.

Counsel for the State to also inform the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran-respondent No.2 about the order which has been passed by this Court today.
