1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. After arguing at length, learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide the representation (Annexure P- 11), dated 16.01.2020.
3. Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 & 2 only.
4. Mr. Manish Jain, Addl. P.P. UT. accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 & 2 and on instructions from Shri Kewal Krishan, DSP (Traffic), UT, Chandigarh, states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and that decision would be taken on the representation (Annexure P-11) dated 16.01.2020 by respondent No.1 within such time, as is granted by this Court.
5. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above, the Crl. writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P- 11), dated 16.01.2020, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, preferably within 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
