Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 01.10.2019 (Annexure P-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the interest on the reversional pay scale @8% has not been granted to the petitioners whereas the similarly situated employees have been granted the interest @8% in CWP-1885-2011 titled as Mahinder Pal and others Vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 11.05.2016

Learned counsel for the petitioners further states that the petitioner have also issued a legal notice dated 01.10.2019 (Annexure P-7), to respondent No.2-The Director Secondary Education, Haryana, which has not been decided till date.

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At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, if their legal notice dated 01.10.2019 (Annexure P-7), is decided by respondent No.2 within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gaurav Gulzar Singh Chauhan, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners during the hearing of the present petition, but without going into the merits of the case, respondent No.2-The Director Secondary Education, Haryana, is directed to look into the legal notice dated 01.10.2019 (Annexure P-7), and decide the same within two month after receiving the copy of this order, in accordance with law.
